

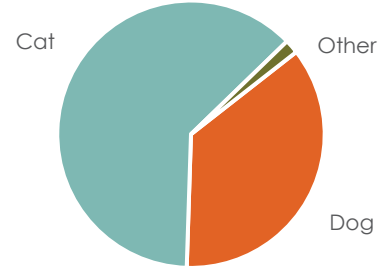


Total Live Animal Admission

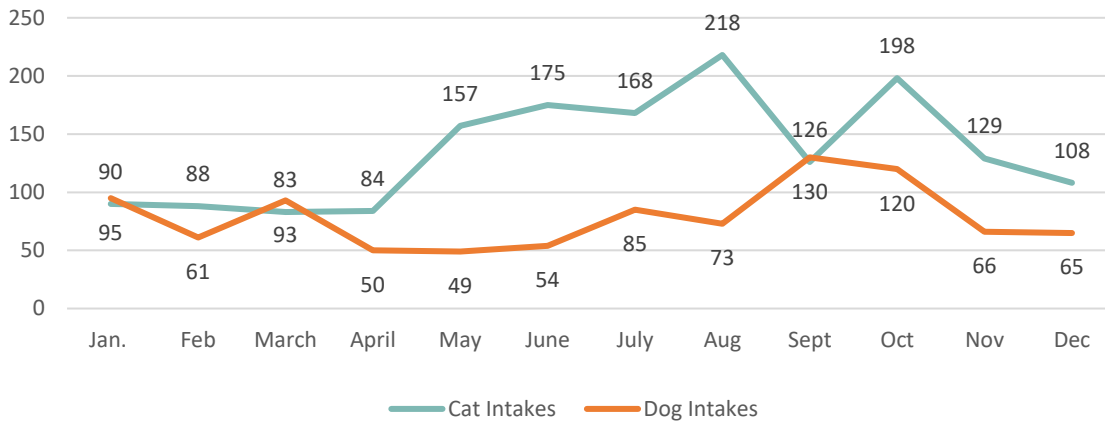
Animals Admitted

During 2020, 2,609 animals were admitted. Of the 2,609 animals taken in, 36.1% were dogs and 62.2% were cats. Other intakes (1.7%) were other pets, primarily domestic rabbits and guinea pigs.

Animals Admitted: 2020

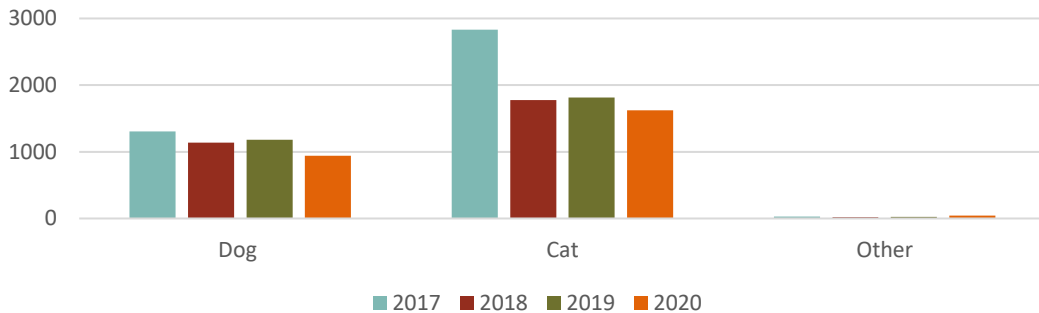


Animals Admitted: 2020 Monthly Intake



There was a decrease in overall admission from 2017, which was 4,164 animals. This was due to a more controlled intake process, primarily with surrendered pets and reported strays during our peak months.

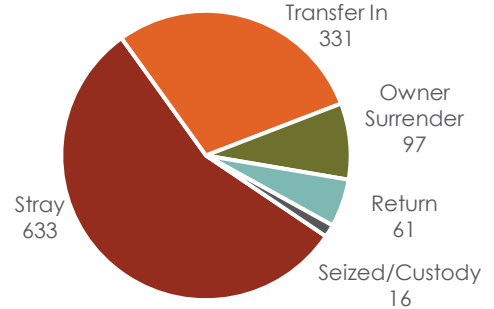

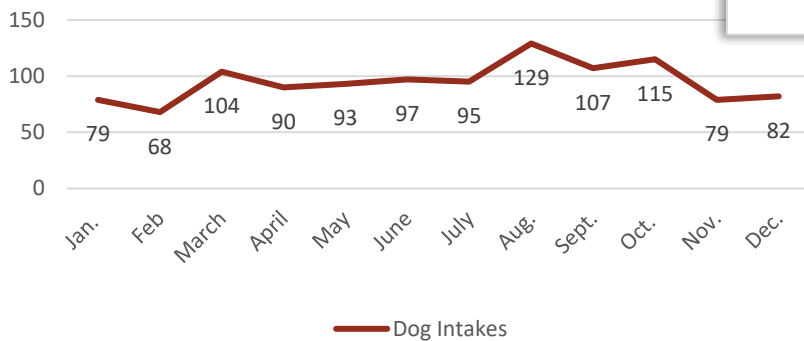
Sheltered Dog Intakes

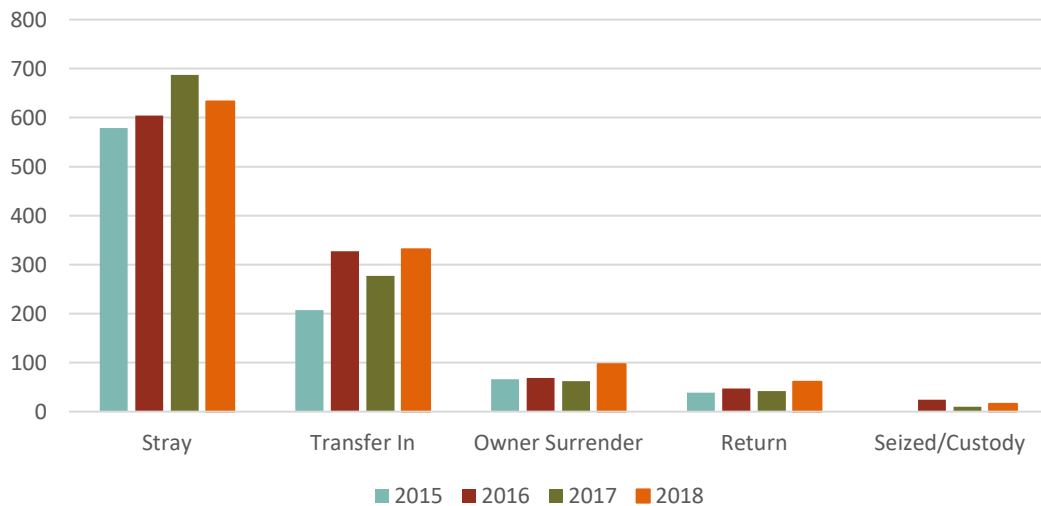
Sheltered Dog Intakes: 2020

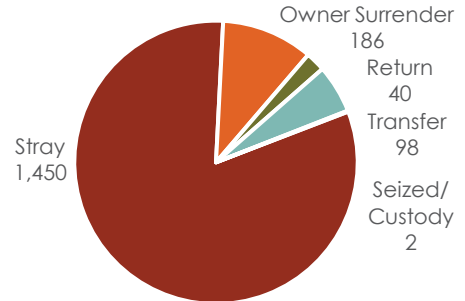

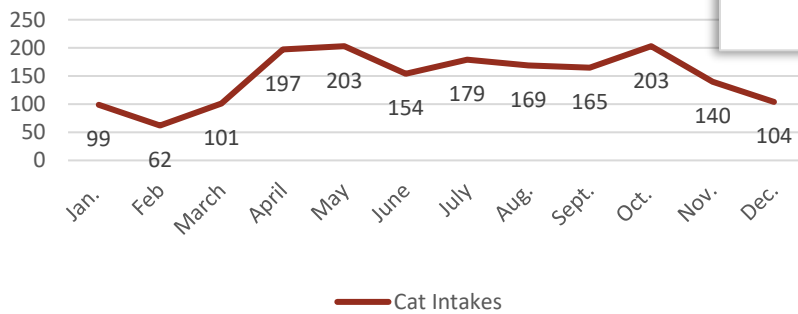
Sheltered Cat Intakes

There were 1,776 live cats admitted to the shelter in 2020: 81.64% were strays and 10.47% were owner surrendered.

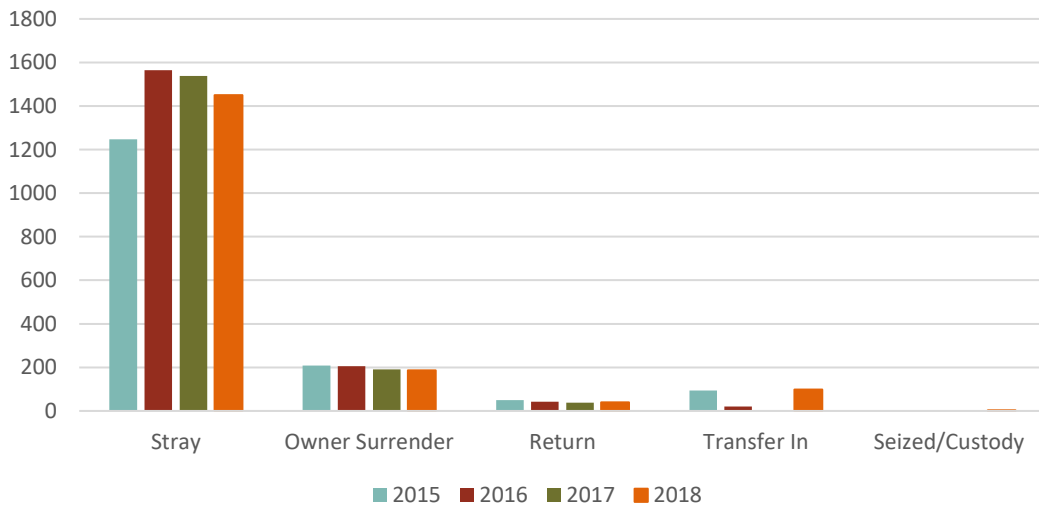
Sheltered Cat Intakes: 2020

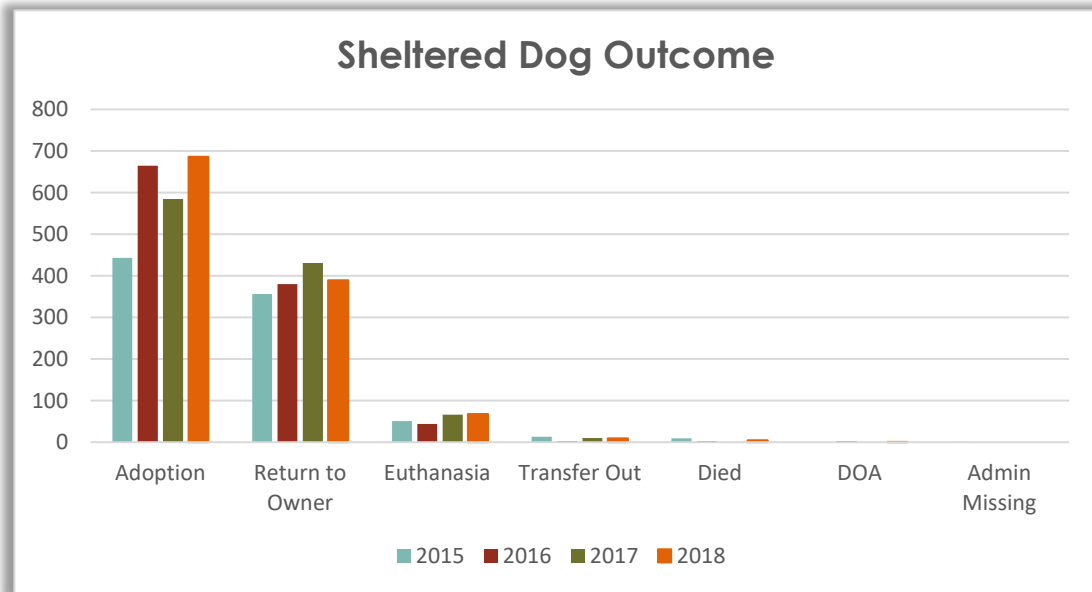
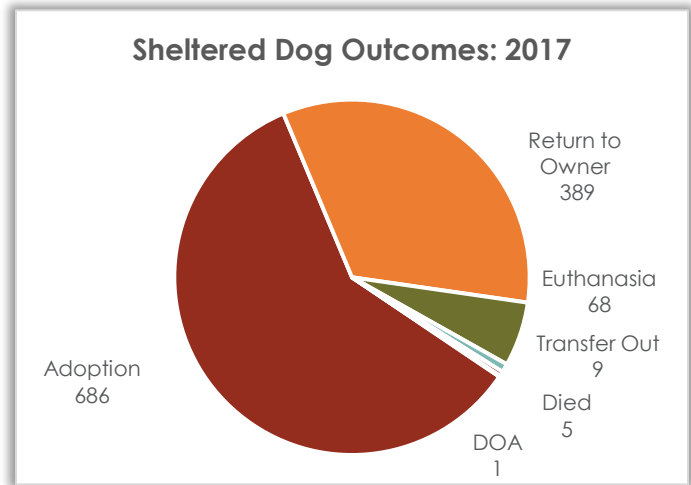

Sheltered Dog Outcomes

Outcomes for dogs admitted to the shelter in 2020 were primarily adoption (59.24%) and return to owner (33.59%).

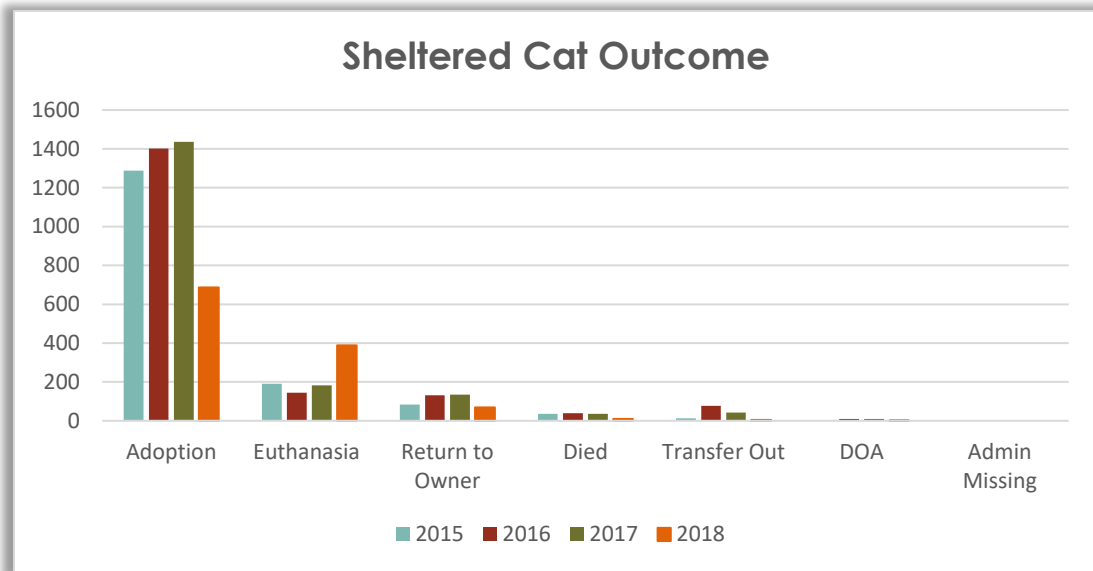
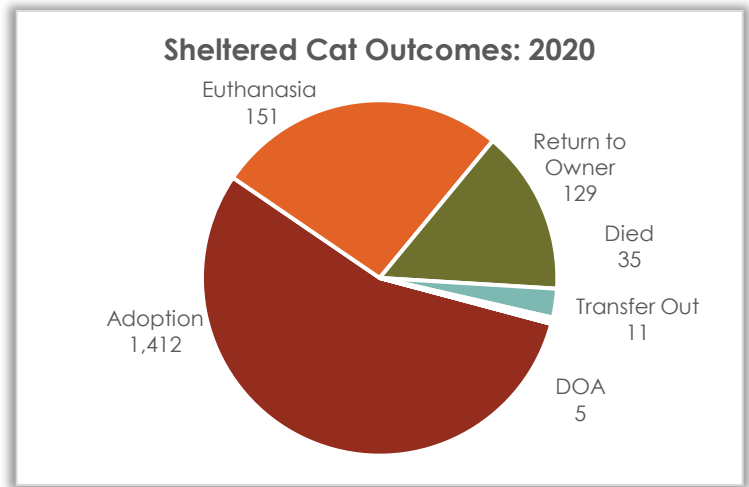


Sheltered Cat Outcome

Outcomes for cats admitted at the shelter were primarily adoption (77.88%). 7.31% of the admitted cats were reclaimed by or returned to an owner.

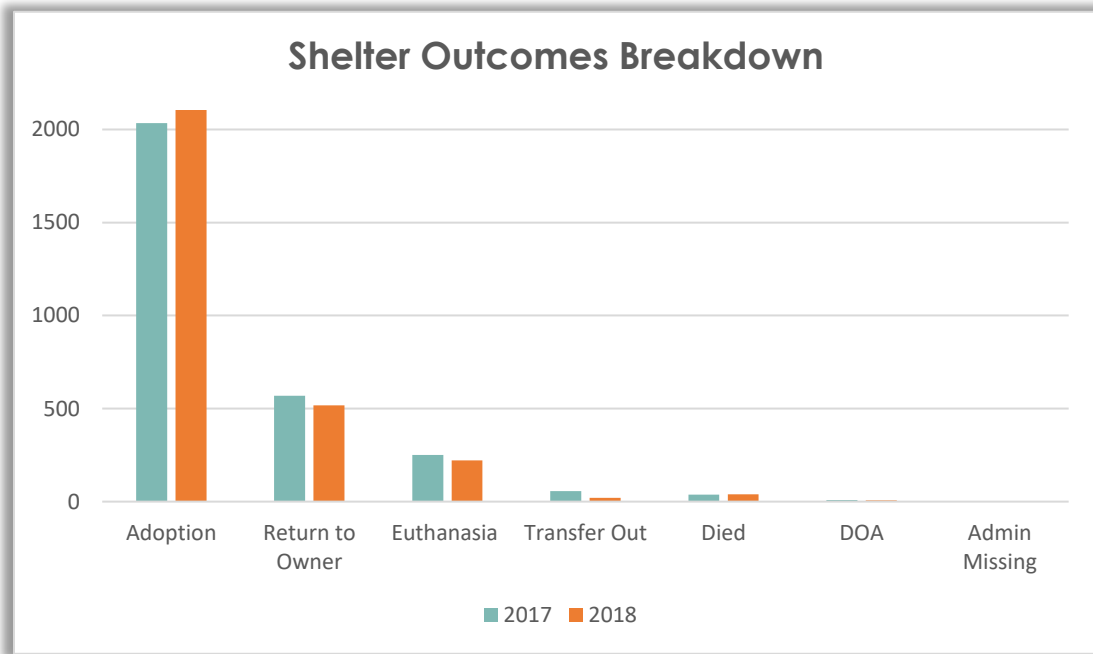
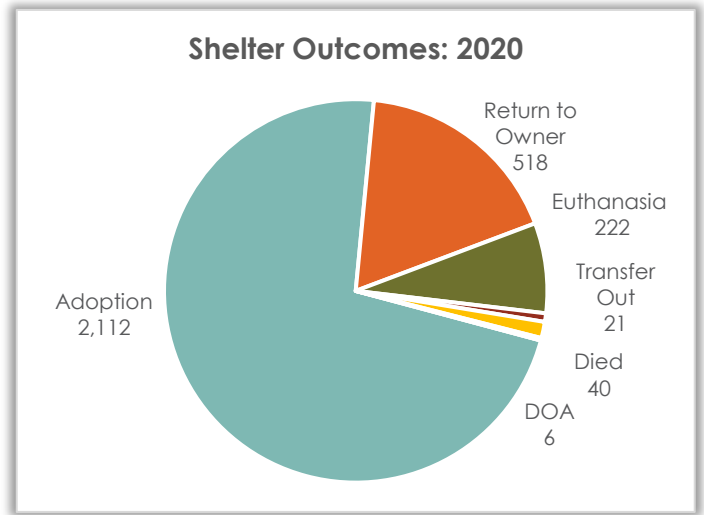
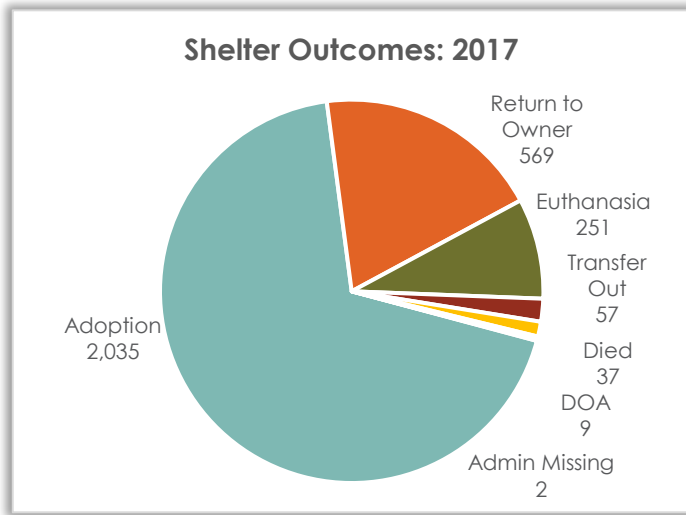

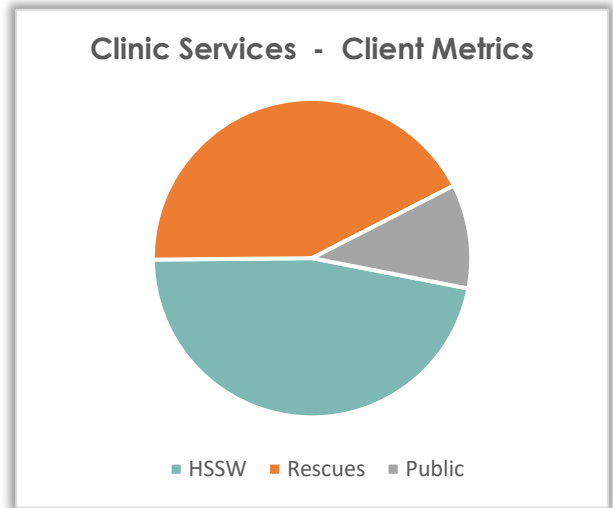


Clinic Services - 2020 Information

Clinic Services

In 2020, the Humane Society of Southern Wisconsin further expanded its Clinic Services. In 2017, HSSW partnered with two cat rescue groups to provide low-cost veterinary and surgical services; in 2020, HSSW partnered with 11 pet rescues. Additionally, in October of 2020, HSSW started offering spay & neuter services to the public, one day a week.

There were 3,048 animals spayed or neutered by the shelter's medical team. Of the total spay/neuter surgeries, 1,366 were HSSW's shelter pets, 1,373 were pets belong to partnering rescues, and 309 were pets belonging to the public.
