





Total Animal Intake


Animals Admitted

During 2021, 2,844 animals were admitted. Of the 2,844 animals taken in, 37.8% were dogs, 59.2% were cats, and 2.9% were critters, primarily domestic rabbits and guinea pigs.





There was a decrease in overall admission from 2018. This was due to a more controlled intake process and an effort to help pets go home again without stepping foot in the shelter. The introduction of our Fearless Foster Program allowed us to grow our intake of critters, mostly guinea pigs and domestic rabbits.

Outcomes for cats were primarily adoption (81.0%) and return to owner (11.5%).







Clinic Services

Clinic Services

In 2021, the Humane Society of Southern Wisconsin continued providing its low-cost Clinic Services to both community members and rescue partners. In 2021, HSSW performed clinic services for nine rescue partners. Additionally, all 2021, HSSW offered low-cost and at times no-cost spay and neuter services to the community.

There were 2,108 animals spayed or neutered by the shelter's veterinary team. Of the total spay/neuter surgeries, 1,557 were HSSW's shelter pets, 346 were pets belong to partnering rescues, and 205 were pets belonging to the public.
